BUILDING CAPACITY, EXPANDING OPPORTUNITY

THE NEED

In 1981, the Program for Theological Education by Extension (PTEE) began its important mission out of a modest office space in Amman, Jordan. By God's tremendous grace and through the generosity of many partners and donors around the world, the PTEE has steadily grown over the years to be an outstanding regional educational program, equipping Christian leaders on location with vital skills to minister in their churches and communities.

With continued program expansion, the PTEE Ministry Center in Amman has outgrown more than one office space, and since 2004, has been operating out of two stories of a three-storey building.

For several years, the PTEE has considered buying or constructing a building to provide it with necessary material stability and freedom of use of the space it occupies. While renting office space has been a workable option so far, remaining within that framework subjects the growing program to the whims of landlords, rental hikes and a degree of instability that comes from not owning the property outright.

THE PROJECT

The PTEE has an urgent need for an adequate and flexible physical space from which to administer and develop its expanding programs. After extensive research and consideration of multiple options, the PTEE has determined that the building from which it presently operates serves as the best fit for its current program needs and its future visions for expansion.

The PTEE Ministry Center is located in the heart of the city of Amman and is easily accessible by several public transportation routes. It is in a quiet neighborhood, and is surrounded by buildings with Christian owners who have a very positive relationship with the program.

The building's configuration allows for several larger meeting spaces and a library space. It has a basement guest apartment that enables the PTEE to extend hospitality on a regular basis. The maintenance and utilities costs are reasonable. The building design allows for constructing a fourth floor, which could easily accommodate future program growth

THE COST

The total purchase price of the building is **\$866,000**. The estimated cost of basic renovations and installation of an elevator is **\$85,000** for the 1000 square meter space.

Total Cost: \$950,000.00
